




The process in 8 easy steps

- student/graduate makes appointment to meet with Internship Liaison officer
- student prepares original work into files/showreel/portfolio
- student/graduate meets with Internship Liaison officer to discuss internship and learning outcomes
- STUDENT IS THE PERFECT CANDIDATE
- internship is secured and locked down with employee
- student and employee sign learning contract
- internship must be 120 hours minimum
- student prepares 1000 word report (against learning outcomes)
- student receives a mark following discussions with employee




