ENTRY REQUIREMENTS & SELECTION CRITERIA

ACADEMIC -

Successful completion of Australian Year 10 or equivalent.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY -

Successful completion of 8 weeks of General English at Intermediate level or equivalent (plus 80% attendance) at English Unlimited or 10 weeks at other approved providers.

COURSE OVERVIEW & STRUCTURE

APC's Certificate III in Design Fundamentals will introduce students to foundation skills to launch their career in a creative industry. Students will experience a variety of projects to begin shaping their design style and inform their progression to an area of specialisation. Building from a base of history and theory students will follow the design process and collaborate with their peers to explore colour, drawing, 2D & 3D, typography, page layout and industry software.

PATHWAYS

Students who successfully complete the Certificate III in Design Fundamentals may continue onto the Diploma of Graphic Design, Diploma of Interior Design or Diploma of Applied Fashion Design and Merchandising courses at Australian Pacific College (subject to prerequisite requirements).

ASSESSMENTS

All APC vocational courses are assessed through a combination of assessment types that may include short answer questions, studio projects, essays, reports, group tasks, portfolios and/or presentations.
