

SPECIALISATION ELECTIVE STREAMS

COURSE OUTCOMES

To achieve the qualification of SHB50115 Diploma of Beauty Therapy, **25 Units of Competency must be completed**. The 25 Units of Competency are comprised of 13 Core Units, 9 General Elective Units plus 3 Specialisation Elective units.

FURTHER STUDY PATHWAYS

Ella Baché College has an articulation agreement with Victoria University. Graduates of the SHB50115 Diploma of Beauty Therapy will receive 8 subjects of credit (equivalent to the first year of the 4-year Bachelor of Dermal Sciences degree. Graduates who meet the University entry requirements will be offered a place and can enter the program at the start of the second year. The Dermal Therapies Degree at Victoria University can beattempted and completed online from the second year onwards.

COURSE OUTCOMES

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GRADUATE AND ARTICULATION PATHWAYS

International Student Graduates of the Diploma of Beauty Therapy qualification may:

- Apply for the credit transfer pathway into the Victoria University Bachelor of Dermal Sciences degree. Our Diploma of Beauty Therapy graduates gain eight credit points (equivalent to one year of study) into this four-year Bachelorlevel course. This degree is a CRICOS-Approved course.
- ITEC Qualification: gain an additional international qualification with ITEC, the UK's leading awarding body for professional qualifications in Beauty Therapy.
- CIDESCO: Comite International d'Esthetique et de Cosmetologie, is the world's leading international Beauty Therapy Association. Founded in 1946 with its head office in Zurich, Switzerland, CIDESCO is represented in over 33 countries and issues the world's most prestigious qualifications in the field of aesthetics and beauty therapy. CIDESCO International Schools are overseen by CIDESCO to ensure that they adhere to the most rigorous standards of education, assessment and facilities and that graduates are of the highest calibre. Opportunities and advancement possibilities are much greater for CIDESCO Diploma holders and for those who are serious about building a career.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

 It is important to note that prior to practicing on clients, students are expected to perform treatments on each other during practical training sessions throughout the course. It is an essential part of learning experience which enables students to experience the 'philosophy' of beauty therapy, to feel and understand what is being experienced by clients. In addition, students will need to stand for a prolonged timeframe while performing treatments. The treatment timeframe can range from 15 minutes upwards depending on the treatment.

WORK EXPERIENCE

- All students are required to complete 150 hours of external work experience in a beauty salon. This will enable students to gain invaluable practical experience.
- Work experience can be undertaken at any salon; it is not a requirement that work experience be completed at an Ella Baché salon. Please note: Ella Baché salons are independently owned and operated.
- Work experience hours are in addition to the course hours.
- Work experience does not count towards the assessment of the course.
- Work experience will be done concurrently with study and may commence during Trimester 2 or later in the course. Incomplete work experience hours can be completed at the end of the course as required.
- Our Trainers assists students to prepare for work experience and where possible to find a work experience placement.

LIVING IN SYDNEY

ARTARMON CAMPUS
