

IPL & LASER FOR HAIR REDUCTION



This is an entry level course that offers participants a pathway into the IPL and Laser industry, specialising in hair reduction treatments. This course is recommended for participants who have a background in beauty services who are currently working in the industry and wish to improve their skills and knowledge. Upon successful completion of this course you may be eligible to enrol into the 10038NAT Graduate Certificate of cosmetic laser and light therapies.

Participants who are not currently working in beauty services are eligible to enrol into this course and are required to complete the following prerequisites prior to course commencement:

- Laser safety for cosmetic laser and light therapies No ED186 (online)
- Introduction to dermal science (distance learning)

You will learn:

- Analysing skin conditions
- Types of unwanted hair growth
- Designing and evaluating IPL and laser treatment programs for hair reduction
- Consultation techniques
- Performing and assessing test patches
- Delivering safe and effective treatments
- Selecting and using laser / IPL technology
- Follow-up and aftercare advice
- Documentation requirements
- Compliance with regulatory requirements

Participants are required to bring a model.

- Introduction to dermal science (non-beauty background)
