## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

**ACADEMIC** - Successful completion of Australian Year 12 or equivalent.

### ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY -

Successful completion of 10 weeks of General English at Advanced level (plus 80% attendance) at our sister school, English Unlimited, or at other approved providers.

In addition, all applicants must satisfactorily complete the TESOL interview.

## PATHWAYS

Successful graduates who also hold an undergraduate degree will be eligible to teach English in Australia to non-English-speaking students. This qualification is also suitable for teaching overseas.

## COURSE OVERVIEW & STRUCTURE

This course aims to develop the skills and knowledge required for teaching English to non-English speaking learners in a variety of contexts, both in Australia and overseas. During the course you will develop your understanding of essential theory related to Teaching English as a Second or Foreign Language whilst also developing your practical teaching skills in the classroom.
